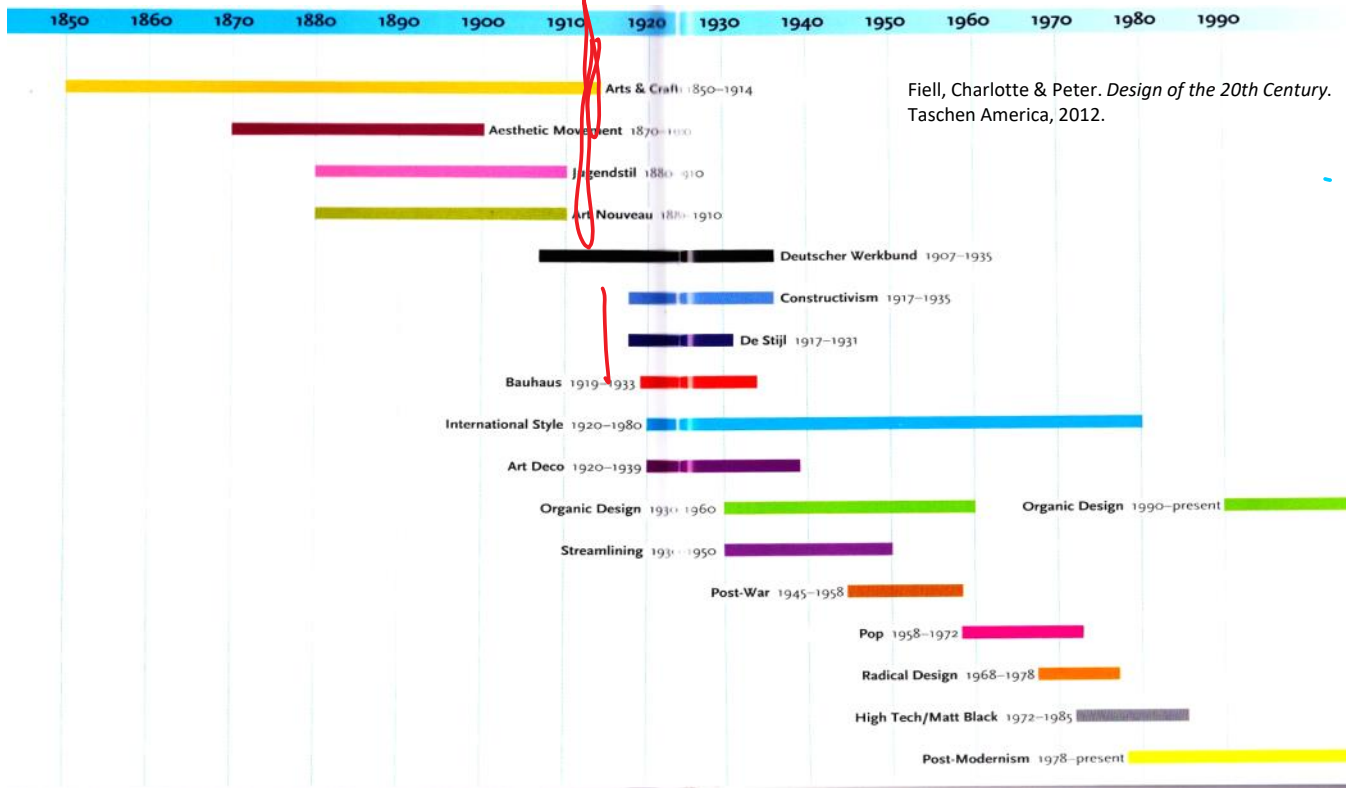
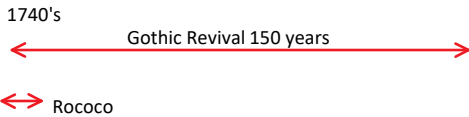
20th Century Timeline

Crosses

Dark color palettes
Expression of wealth
Shadows

Arts and Crafts Movement

Industrial revolution separated the work of design from fabrication; prior, craftsmen did both.

Design as a stand-alone discipline had no theory or context; as a result, much low quality was produced.
