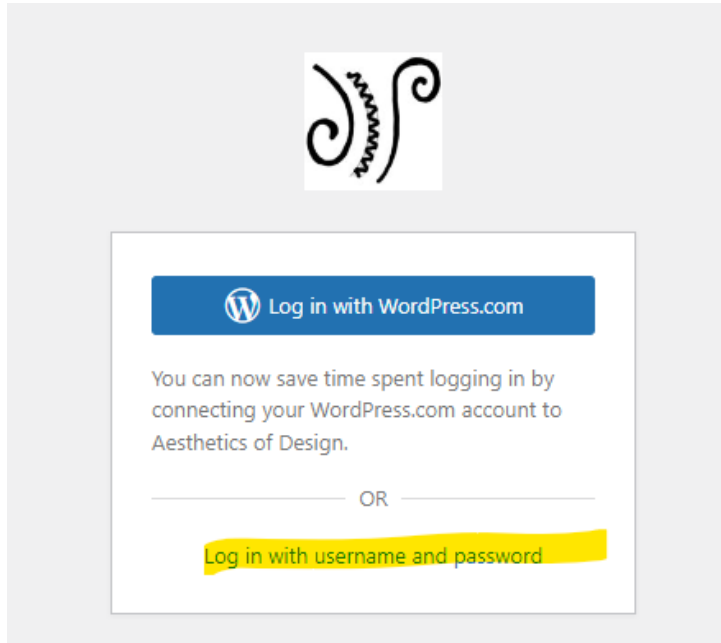


Creating a Gravatar profile and picture

To add a profile picture you need to connect your wordpress account to the username/password provided that gives you author access into AesDes.org


1. Sign in with your given username and password that starts with aau2024_____



2. Go to your profile and click to change your profile picture using Gravatar and click to sign in (top right corner).



3. Create an account, use **the same email/username/password** that is on your original profile to create a new wordpress account. If you cannot find the email – slack Shrey Solanki or email me at shrey.solanki@colorado.edu.

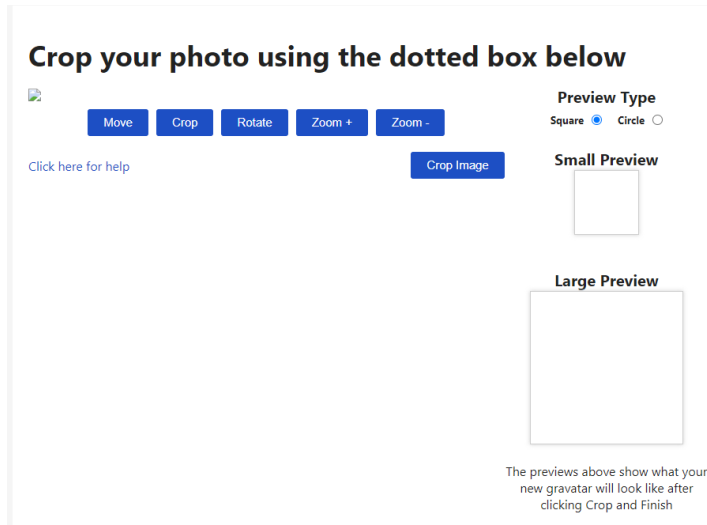
2. Pick new image

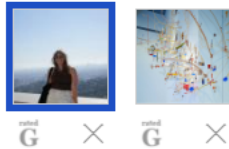
